Read the following passage carefully and then answer the questions.

A good library with hundreds even thousands of books is essential for anybody who studies seriously after primary school. Nobody can afford to buy all the books he needs and no school can afford to supply every pupil with every book he will need. But a copy of most books useful to pupils can be bought for the school library for all pupils to use.

All good school libraries have two main sections. From the lending section you can borrow books and take them away for a week or perhaps fortnight, no longer, from the reference section you can not under any excuse remove books. You must read then in the reading room which is a part of the reference section.

The books in the lending section are divided into two main groups, fiction and non-fiction. The fiction part consists of all the store books or novels as they are usually called. A good secondary school library will have hundreds perhaps thousands of novels, old ones and modern ones.

The non-fiction part consists of study books on science, history, geography, woodwork and art. There will be hundreds of these too.

Now how do you find the book you want among all these books? The library will have a catalogue in which is shown the name of the author and the title of every book. If you want to find a particular novel you need to find from the catalogue the name of the author. All the fiction books arranged on the shelves alphabetically by family name of the author. So on the shelves marked F, you will find all the books by all the authors whose family names begin with the letter F.

To find a non-fiction book is a little more difficult. Once again the library catalogue will help you. For example if you want is about the planets, the catalogue will tell you not only its name and author but also that it is a science book and that is belongs to the branch of science called astronomy. So you go to the shelf marked "Astronomy" and there you will find it, placed according to first letter of the name of the author.


